

## Iga Ueno Castle Town

Centered around Iga Ueno Castle, originally designed by the renowned castle architect Todo Takatora, the old castle town retains the atmosphere of the Edo period. As you stroll past traditional shops and streets rich in historical charm, you'll encounter places associated with Matsuo Basho, the famous haiku master born in Iga. the hidden charms of Iga's townscape?



Ninjas, now familiar figures in the worlds of anime and film, are said to have originated in Iga. This historical legacy can still be felt throughout the old castle town, where traces remain—such as the district named "Shinobi-cho" (Ninja Town).



The castle town of Iga Ueno still retains its traditional shops and historic streets, earning it the nickname "Little Kyoto." The Danjiri procession of the Ueno Tenjin Festival, where decorated floats and people dressed as demons parade through the town's autumn streets, is recognized as one of the Yama, Hoko, Yatai float festivals listed on the UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage list.



## Matsuo Basho A master of haiku born in Iga

Haiku, a poetic form composed of just 17 syllables in a 5-7-5 pattern, is known for its brevity and depth. Born in Iga during the Edo period, Matsuo Basho enhanced the artistic depth of haiku. He became famous for his travels across Japan, leaving behind renowned works such as Nozarashi Kiko (The Records of a Weather-Exposed Skeleton) and Oku no Hosomichi (The Narrow Road to the Deep North).




